- Item 1: Call to Order**

- In question last month about the \$16,000 in contingency, we used that to pay 2019 fire tax to the county.
- Code Enforcement is trying to contact Ms. Hamby at 7045 Reinhardt College Parkway
- The house at 6171 Reinhardt College Parkway code enforcement is keeping check on them for cleanup
- Next Dumpster Day is March 25<sup>th</sup>
- There is a leak at 438 Bartow St. Stanley suggested that if we have money left from GEFA project to replace lines on Bartow, Byars and Lee St. Council requested that a letter be sent to Ms. Romano letting her know our decision.

**Item 8: City Attorney's Report**

- It appears City of Canton has signed the resolution for the exchange of water service
- Need to find out if the resolutions are sufficient to update the water map
- Easements – the Cline and Church easements have been obtained. Update sketch sent to Mr. Meadows. Mr. Meadows sent a request to address temporary structures and damages. It was decided that he was to reply to Mr. Meadows with our ordinance.

No remarks.


**Item 10: Adjourn Regular Council Meeting**
