- Item 1: Call to Order**  
Mayor Mary Helen Lamb, called the meeting to order with a quorum present.
- Item 2: Pledge of Allegiance/Innovation**  
Mayor Lamb led the Pledge to the Flag
- Item 3: Consideration to Approve Regular Council Meeting Minutes July 11, 2022**  
Mayor Mary Helen Lamb asked for a motion to approve the Public Hearing minutes for Distilled Spirits. A motion was made by Councilmember Bosch, seconded by Councilmember Cochran and approved by all members present.

- Item 5: Water System Report**
- Nathan Pressley contacted Stanley Townsend about Sardis Circle. They have 13 customers that Mr. Pressley wanted on another road connected to Sardis but Cherokee County would not allow the road. The 2" line going on Sardis will not accommodate 13 customers.
  - Larry Lewallen wants water from Salacoa back to Waleska. Stanley's suggestion is to set a 2" meter at Salacoa. He will be meeting with

Dwayne from Cherokee County Water tomorrow and hopes to get an answer on Fate Conn pump station.

- Stanley reported that the Abbott Rd meter has been installed.
- Stanley asked where the liquor store wanted their meter and the city manager reported that she told their contractor it would be set next to their other one.
- Lamar Rogers reported that Stanley will locate meters on Hwy 108 and Turnipseed will come behind him and do survey.

**Item 6: City Manager Report**

- City manager reported that she had gotten prices from City of Canton on their irrigation meter and theirs was \$775, and City of Woodstock's is \$820. There was no decision to change our prices.
- City manager received an email with an update from Nathan Brandon about Geneva Rd and Frances Rd. He stated that at this time they just want to focus on Frances Rd. He asked if the City of Waleska would be willing to cover \$2500 that they were short. A motion was made by Councilmember Bosch, seconded by Councilmember Cochran to approve the \$2500 and start on the lines, and seconded by all members present. The next step will be Stanley looking at the property, then we will give them 30 day notice and work out paying for lines and meters. We are estimating 8-12 weeks to start.
- City Manager reported that she had put the bank balances in their packet.
- City Manager asked about an app that she had got information on for the city. Everyone thought it was a good idea. A motion was made by Councilmember Bosch to implement the app at a cost of \$1500 set up fee and \$75 a month, and can cancel at any time, seconded by Councilmember Lee Lamb, and approved by all members present.

- Mayor Lamb mentioned the 911 dinner we always do for fire and sheriff's office and this year it falls on Sunday. Everyone agreed to hold it on Sunday at 5pm.
